Masterclass on Anne Frank's Story and Its Canadian Connections

Join us for a deeper look into Anne Frank's story, presented by the Anne Frank House in Amsterdam, the Netherlands. This 45-minute presentation is suitable for teachers, students and the general public. Learn more about the historical context in which Anne lived, her conditions in hiding, and the important connections between Canada and the Netherlands both during and after the war. The facilitator is a professional Anne Frank House educator and will model best practices for teaching and learning about Anne Frank. The presentation will feature rich visual content, and allow time for questions.

It is recommended, but not required, that participants follow both this program and the virtual tour of the secret annex where Anne and seven other people hid.

Join us for a closer look inside the building where Anne and her family went into hiding for more than two years. Accompanied by a live Anne Frank House guide, the visit is based on computerized images and enhanced with quotes from Anne's diary. The facilitator is a professional Anne Frank House educator and will model best practices for teaching and learning about Anne Frank. The presentation will feature rich visual content, and allow time for questions.
